Manyworlds 3D

Manyworlds 3D is a concert performance of Rolf Wallin's 30 minute orchestral work *Manyworlds*, featuring stereographically projected, fractal generated 3D film by Boya Bøckman. Film clips are synchronized and tuned to the orchestra by a musician, thus freeing the orchestra and conductor from following click tracks etc. At the moment, this synchronization must be done by the percussionist Eirik Raude.

The picture is generated by 4 projectors joined to create one 3D image behind the orchestra. Due to the light output lost in the process of projecting 3D, back projection is preferred. In order to control the concert lights for the musicians to an acceptable level for both performers and viewers, all musicians must have stand lights, separated into three dimmer channels.

Film Hire €700 for one performance. Cost is €350 for subsequent performances in the same run.

Technical requirements:

- Back projection screen preferred
- Projection screen size: 15 x 6 m
- Screen masked by black draping
- Min. space behind screen: 6 m
- Risers to bring the projector @ 3m hight
- Alternately front /overhead truss-rigged projectors
- Minimum projector specs in the event of us not bringing our own system: Dolby 3D equipped HD projector with 12000 ansilumen.

Lights

- Music stand lights for all musicians
- Three separate dimmer channels for music stand lights
- Top/backlight profile for the conductor

Local crew

- 1 light technician rigging and participating in all rehearsals with video and concert(s).
- 1 stage technician rigging only
- crew to hand out/collect/clean 3D glasses these can be washed in a regular washing machine temperature 60 degrees. 1000 glasses will take ca. 2-3 on short program.

Schedule
